

Nominations: You may nominate any rescued Doberman – your own, your friend’s, one from your rescue group or shelter – any rescued Doberman.

Eligibility: Any rescued Doberman, alive at the close of the previous year’s nominations, is eligible to be nominated for this award.

For purposes of the Judith Fellton Memorial Award a rescued Doberman is one that has been obtained from a rescue organization or a shelter or such like facility for homeless animals. A stray that is found and kept by the finder would also be considered a rescue. Unless medically indicated, rescues are expected to be spayed/neutered. A dog purchased from a pet store or breeder, regardless of the purchaser’s motivation, or a dog that is directly re-homed by a responsible breeder is not considered a rescue.
